“Budget Development & Negotiation for Investigative Sites” (session W193) will be presented on Wednesday, May 25, 2011 at 8 am by Derek Grimes, Senior Director of Clinical Operations. This session is designed to provide attendees with the key components to preparing for effective budget negotiations: understanding costs and developing infrastructure and methodology to consistently maximize revenue; payment terms and collections; and how financial statements work. Derek is responsible for operations of TKL’s five domestic research centers that conduct Phase 1–4 studies in multiple therapeutic areas including dermatology, pain and diabetes. Prior to TKL, Derek was the Executive Administrator at New York University Bluestone Center for Clinical Research, a general research center that manages both NIH and industry-sponsored grants. He is a member of International Association of Dental Research (IADR) and is currently completing an MBA at St. Joseph’s College.
